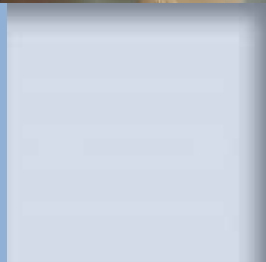
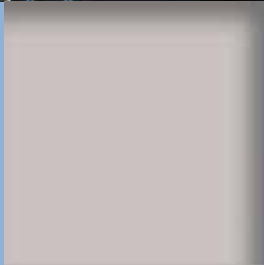

We offer a varied and balanced curriculum, which focuses on developing lifelong skills. We have developed a successful 'pathways' approach to personalise learning and develop our students as confident, resilient individuals.

All abilities can succeed, as we offer early GCSE and A level entry and a wide ranging vocational provision, including Motor Vehicle studies and Hair & Beauty.

Additional support is provided for students who find learning difficult, either by providing learning assistants in the classroom or by working in small groups. Regular homework extends learning and the school organiser helps students become independent learners.

St Peter's operates a Faculty structure, with each Faculty in its own suite of rooms. Attractive and inspiring displays create an atmosphere where learning can take place. We encourage a sense of purpose in students and provide opportunities such as participation in national competitions. Achievements are celebrated in a variety of ways to encourage and promote a desire to succeed.

Our Sixth Formers are offered a caring, positive and challenging environment with smaller classes and committed and experienced teaching staff. Students receive a high level of individual attention.

Our Sixth Form is inclusive and provides appropriate courses to meet the needs of students with a wide range of interests and abilities.

The refurbished Sixth Form area provides a stimulating environment, including the common room and study room with IT facilities.

Sixth Formers have a busy academic schedule and are regularly monitored and mentored. They are encouraged to develop as individuals and contribute to school life and to the community, particularly through charity fund raising. Many go on to study at university.

Our highly praised system of Pastoral Support Managers enables parents to contact the member of staff whose sole responsibility is the well-being of all the students in the year group.

We create an environment where young people investigate technological solutions for the future. Technology plays an important role in every faculty area, enhancing teaching and providing stimulating and engaging lessons. Our state of the art Recording Studio adds value to the work of many subjects and students are encouraged to become involved in Saint FM, the local community radio station broadcasting from St Peter's.

St. Peter's is at the heart of the community.

Saint FM is unique as a community radio station because it is hosted by the school and run by adult and student volunteers. It broadcasts across the Maldon District and beyond via the internet.

The local Children's Centre is located on the school site.

We have a flourishing Duke of Edinburgh Award Club and a wide range of other clubs available to develop our students' interests and talents. Our students have won awards for their contributions to Anglia in Bloom and helped the town to succeed in the competition. Our musicians perform at many community events.

St. Peter's boasts outstanding sporting facilities. Our extensive school grounds include an all-weather multi-activity pitch, several football and rugby pitches, tennis courts and a cricket square and nets. Indoor sporting facilities include a fully equipped gymnasium, drama/dance studio, multi-discipline sports hall and benefit from recently refurbished changing facilities

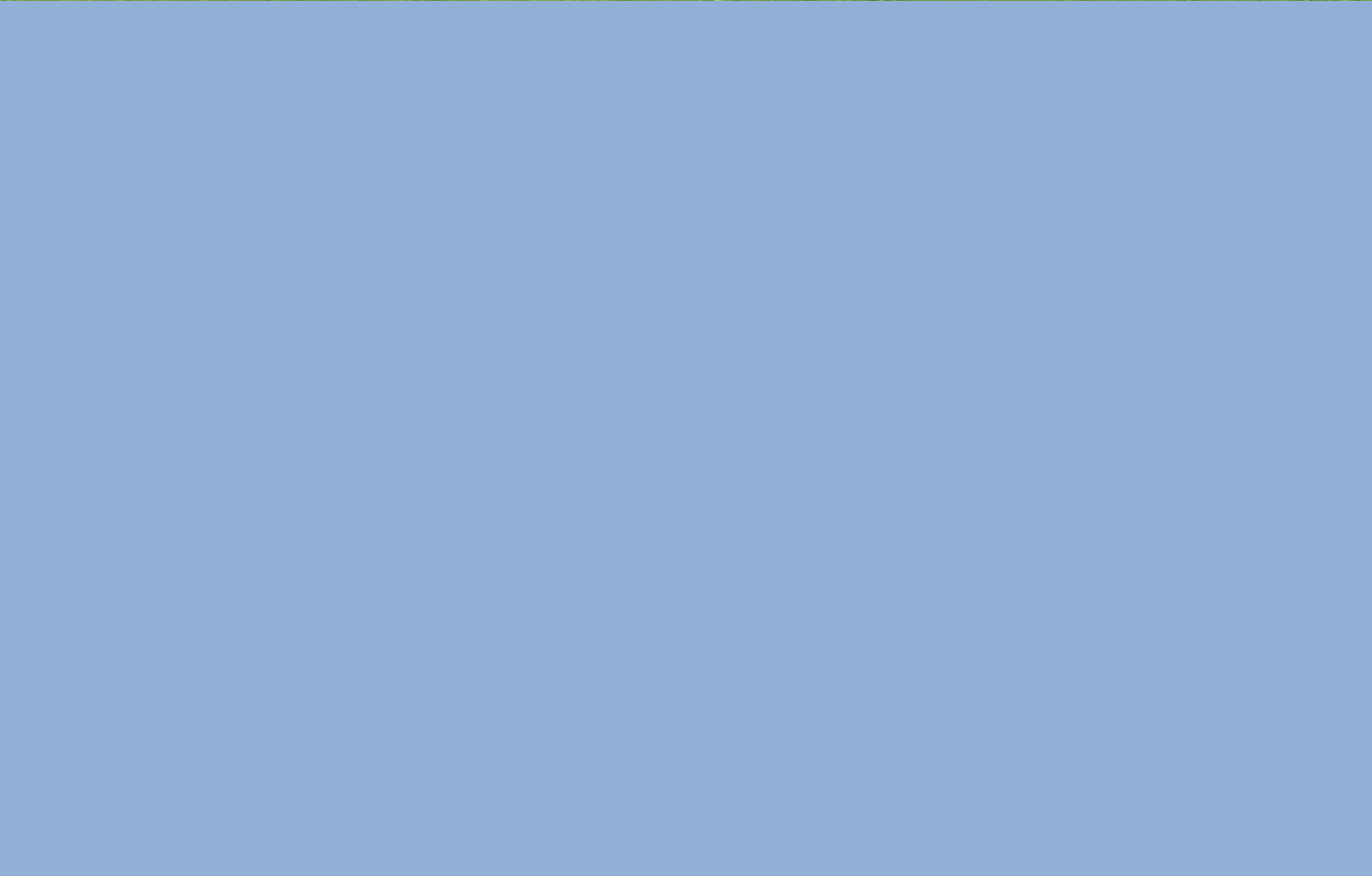
